For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes...

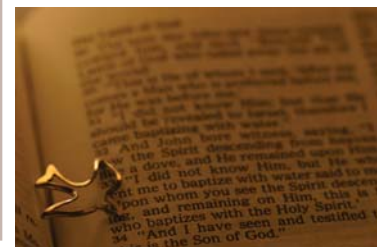

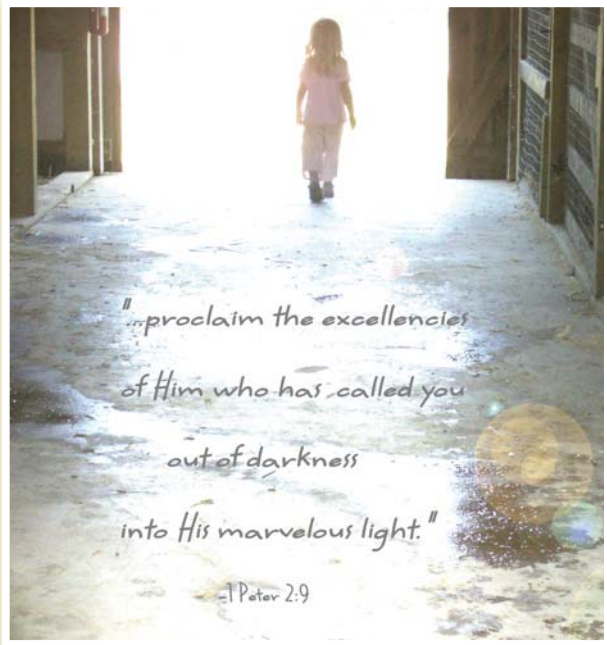


The AALC is a body which directs its mission to all
